## Tea Towel Cutting Instructions:

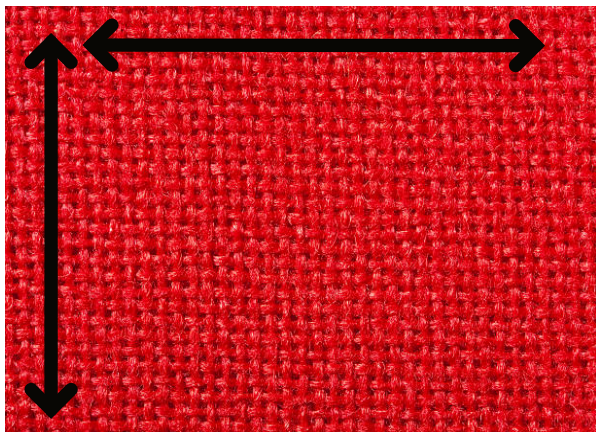
There are no strict rules for your tea towel 🥰

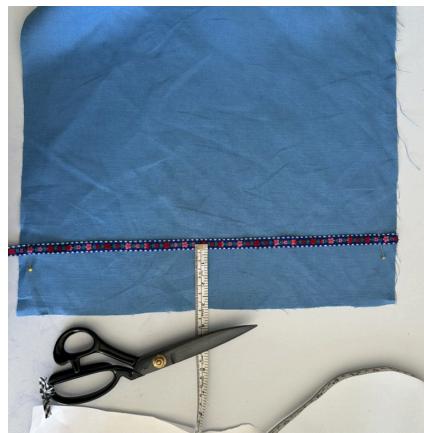
Essential Sewing Tips for Beginners

Fabric Preparation: Try and cut the edges as straight with the fabric grain as possible.

This simple means to cut in line with the woven threads of the fabric



← 75cm  
A Typical tea towel is around 46 x 70 cm  
BUT: It can be any size you decide to make it!  
50cm  
If you cut your rectangle 50 x 75 cm, it will allow 4-5 cm for the hem and finish around this size.  
This size fits perfectly into 1/2 m of 150cm wide fabric 🥰🌞🌈🦄💖



**Needle Selection:** Use a universal needle size 70 or 80.

**Pressing Matters:** Press your hems before you sew. Turn approx 1cm twice - this is called a double fold hem.

**Stitching** - Use a number 3 straight stitch and stitch as close to the folded edge as you can, enclosing the raw edge.

**Take Your Time:** Don't rush. Carefully read through the entire pattern and instructions before starting, and take it step by step. Most of all enjoy the creative process 🥰🌞🌈🦄💖
