

Essential Sewing Tips for Beginners

Fabric Preparation: Try and cut the edge s as straight with the fabric grain as possible.

This simple means to cut in line with the woven threads of the fabric



A Typical tea towel is around 46 x 70 cm BUT: It can be any size you decide to make it!

If you cut your rectangle 50 x 75 cm, it will allow 4-5 cm for the hem and finish around this size.







Needle Selection: Use a universal needle size 70 or 80.

Pressing Matters: Press your hems before you sew. Turn aprox 1cm twice - this is called a double fold hem.

Stitching - Use a number 3 straight stitch and stitch as close to the folded edge as you can, enclosing the raw edge.
